An EIGHTH REST 9 is equal to half the value of a quarter rest . In $\mathbf{4}, \mathbf{4}$ and $\mathbf{4}$ time:

Two 8th rests equal
1 quarter rest.

4 Quarter rests

Four 8th rests equal
1 half rest.
